2 Corinthians 12: 1-10

A Humbled Man (12:1-6)

- *“necessary”* – to defend his ministry and message
- *“third heaven”* – the presence of God
- *“paradise”* - Persian, the garden of the king

“I will not boast, except in regard to my weaknesses”

A Heavenly Provision (12:7)

How was Paul able to remain humble?

- ***A vision from God***
- ***A “thorn in the flesh” – a sharpened tent stake
“given” by God
“a messenger of Satan”***
- ***“to keep me from exalting myself”***

A Sustaining Promise (12:8-9a)

- ***“three times”*** – many, many times
- ***“My grace . . .”*** - God’s unmerited favor
- ***“My grace . . .”*** – the grace of God, Himself
- ***“My grace is . . .”*** - available now
- ***“My grace is sufficient . . .”*** - more than enough
- ***“My grace is sufficient for you”*** - you!!!
- ***“. . . for power is perfected in weakness”*** – human weakness with a heavenly purpose

A Victorious Proclamation (12:9b-10)

“Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. Therefore I am well content with weaknesses, with persecutions, with insults, with distresses, with persecutions, with difficulties for Christ’s sake; for when I am weak then I am strong.”
